Live Oak: Evergreen, slow growing, up to 80' tall

Swamp Chestnut Oak: slow growing, 40-100' tall

Bald Cypress: deciduous conifer, 50' tall

American Sycamore: Deciduous tree, 50-75 feet tall

Buttonbush: Multi-stem shrub, 6-12' tall
